

# 10 POINT TREE CONTRACTOR HIRING GUIDE AND INFORMATION ABOUT ARBOR ACE

# 1. UTILIZING THE INTERNET TO SEARCH FOR A CONTRACTOR

Google the company name and see what comes up. You should find multiple reviews on Google, Yelp, and Facebook. The vast majority of the reviews should be 5 stars. Most reputable tree companies will have multiple 5.0 Star reviews. Take the time to read them. They will give you a good idea of the company in general. I recommend getting estimates from the companies with the most 5.0 star reviews.

#### 2. LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS

Check for the proper Licenses and Certifications. You can request these from the company you're interviewing and verify on your own. Verify dates of licenses as well. If a crane will be utilized on site check for a crane operator's license as well.

# 3. PUNCTUALITY

Have you put a call into a tree company to schedule an estimate? Did they pick up the call or return the call within a day or two of the initial call? When an appointment is scheduled, did they show up on time?

#### WHAT TO EXPECT FROM YOUR INITIAL CONTACT WITH ARBOR ACE

- · Arbor Ace tries to field all calls whenever possible
- At initial phone call we will ask for potential client info to be texted. Upon receiving the text, we will make a return call to schedule an appointment 24-48 hours from the text. We will work with the client to schedule a time that best suits their needs.

  we will alert you of it as soon as we become aware that it will conflict with our scheduled

#### 4. INSURANCE

Also request to have an insurance certificate emailed to you verifying insurance coverages. Check the dates to make sure the policy is valid through scheduled job duration.

# 5. ESTIMATES

Did estimator show up on time? Was the estimator knowledgeable? Did they answer all your questions? Did they come up with solutions to all your tree problems? Did the proposal match the work discussed and was it presented in a professional manner?

# 7. STAFF

Will the owner personally be working onsite running the job? What are the qualifications of the staff? Are staff members wearing personal protective equipment (helmet, chaps, safety glasses)?

- Does the company have the proper insurance coverages?
